The calendar says it's spring and the course is officially opening on April 1, but to keep our greens in outstanding condition, keep in mind that the grass is just coming out of dormancy. It is especially important to repair your ball marks this time of the year. Ball marks left unrepaired early in the year will be evident for the rest of the golfing season. Please repair your ball marks and also those of your fellow golfers, that get so excited about hitting their shots close to the pin, they forget to repair their mark.

On April 7th, we are going to have the original west 9 greens deep-tine aerified. These greens drain slowly and will be improved by this procedure. I believe we can do this during normal play so the golf course won't have to be shut down. We are also going to have tree root pruning around all of the greens, tees and fairways done sometime this spring. This also will be done during normal play.

Beginning with this newsletter, I would like to highlight one of our maintenance staff each month. They do their best to keep your course looking great throughout the year. Roger Teman is a longtime employee that has served DCC as my assistant and even though he is now semi-retired, he is instrumental to our course's success. Roger is a proud graduate of Delphos St. John's High School and began his career as a building contractor. He can pretty much do everything and because of his vast knowledge, Roger can repair anything here at our club. When not working at our golf course, he likes to spend his free time relaxing at his cottage. Understanding the USGA GHIN Handicap System

Establishing an accurate handicap is essential for the matches you play, and the club events you enter to be held in a fair manner. The process for establishing your handicap is surprisingly simple and quick once you either download the GHIN app on your phone or save the GHIN site as one of your favorites on your computer. After completing your round, it will take less than one minute to enter your score correctly.

- 1. Select the course you played
- 2. Check whether it is your Home course or an Away course
- 3. Be sure the date is correct
- 4. Select the tees from which you played

5. Enter your score

By entering ALL scores, you are creating a fair evaluation of your current game. The USGA GHIN system uses the best 8 scores of your most recent 20 scores to calculate your handicap index. Because of this, you should only be able to play to your handicap about 25% of the time.

Golf has always been about self-governance and following the rules of play. Establishing an accurate handicap means that you are treating all your partners and competitors to a fair match.



A Note From Your Pro

As a follow-up, during the 2024 season many members did not post their scores. It is essential to post every score on the day you play, which ensures accurate adjustments for playing conditions.

<u>New this year</u>: To join our Fall Calcutta, you must record 5 rounds at DCC before you can sign up for the tournament. Golf is a game of honor, and an updated handicap index is required to participate in member events. All 9- or 18- hole scores must be posted.

The GHIN system opens for our course on April 1st. If you need help setting up your app, please feel free to stop in and I will help you get things set up.

A weekly GHIN report will be reviewed to help confirm that members are posting their scores.
