

Maintenance Building Addition




The maintenance building faced overcrowding issues, making it unsafe and inefficient for equipment and personnel navigation. To address this, an addition of 1600 sq ft was made to the existing 2500 sq ft. This provides us with the extra space needed to store tractors and turf equipment, provides a safe winter storage area for 12 golf carts and improves our overall safety.
